



Internship at the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development

Call for candidates

The **Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development** (OECD) in collaboration with the **AQUAE Chair in Water Economics** will host two internship candidates for 6 months to support the OECD work programmes on **water governance** and **circular economy**.

The AQUAE Chair in Water Economics within UNED will support with the selection of the two candidates. The UNED is a research institution that, with the support of the AQUAE Foundation, works on topics such as circular economy, future of water resources, sustainable development, and water management.

The interns will be part of the **OECD Unit for Climate, Water, and SDGs**, within the Cities, Urban Policies, and Sustainable Development Division of the Centre for Entrepreneurship, SMEs, Regions and Cities.

The interns will be based at the **OECD Headquarters**, **2 rue Andre Pascal**, **75016**, **Paris**, **France**.

The internship period is from 1 March 2019 to 1 September 2019.

Job description

The interns will contribute with desk research, drafting reports, data analysis, communication and event organisation, within two work streams:

- The selected candidate for the water governance stream will support the activities of the <u>OECD Water Governance Programme</u>. The Water Governance Programme advises governments at all levels on how to design and implement better water policies. It relies on multi-stakeholder engagement and bottom-up processes to produce policy analysis, policy dialogues, policy standards and a policy forum, <u>notably the OECD Water Governance Initiative</u>.
- The selected candidate for the circular economy stream will support the
 activities of the OECD Programme on the "Economics and Governance of
 Circular Economy in Cities". The Programme aims to shed light on
 challenges and opportunities for circular economy in cities, develop data and
 indicators and provide policy solutions towards the transition to the circular
 economy.





Requirements

The candidate must meet the following **requirements**:

- Enrolled in a University able to sign internship agreements with the OECD
- Full time student in a discipline related to the above programmes of work for the whole 6-month period, preferably a PhD or alternatively in 2nd year of Master in public policy, social sciences, environmental engineering or related disciplines (for the water governance programme) and Master in economics, environmental economics, or related discipline (for the circular economy programme)
- Citizen of an OECD member country

Applicants should have excellent drafting and oral skills in **English**. Knowledge of Spanish and French would be a comparative advantage.

Please note that candidates that do **not meet the above requirements** will not be considered.

Conditions

The selected candidates will receive an allowance of <u>702 €/month</u>, which cannot be cumulated with other paid jobs or consultancy duties, but it can be compatible with **scholarships** (e.g. Erasmus, PhD fellowships, etc.). All other fees and costs (travel, accommodation, visa, etc.) are **not covered by the OECD**.

Interested candidates that fulfil the basic requirements are kindly invited to send a CV and cover letter by <u>14 January 2019</u> to the email of the AQUAE Chair in Water Economics <u>catedraeconomiadelagua@cee.uned.es</u>, indicating in the subject the work stream they wish to apply for: Internship at the OECD – (Water Governance or Circular Economy). The candidates will be finally selected by the OECD.
