Do not forget to establish a correlation between the interpretation of the data and the historical periods analyzed. Likewise, it justifies the importance and connection of the chosen statistical variants. On the other hand, remember that the economy and all EU policies are sensitive to the changes that arise in the international arena, while the reforms and measures implemented in the different stages of its activity are not only the response to the marked needs. by member countries, but also to the changing world.

Finally, in addition to the sources indicated, it seeks to use the contributions of other authors.

Evaluation criteria:

The text will be presented, with 2.5 cm margins, in Times New Roman (12 pt) and 1.5 spacing. The extension will not be more than 6 pages nor less than 3.

The text will be written in accordance with the established academic standards, will include footnotes and a list of sources and bibliography, and must have a maximum length of between 2000 words. Remember that if you insert graphics, images or tables, you must title and number them (indicate their source in the caption and comment on them in the text).

In the case of detecting plagiarism, it will imply a suspension.
